

Support Types

(via all University sources, SPH & Non-SPH)

Grants: This includes direct grants to students; non-service, need-based in nature; often federal Pell grants, school based tuition grants, and university need-based aid grants.

Loans: All public & private loans are included; for example, both federal unsubsidized loans, Perkins loans, and federal direct plus loans that are administered by the University.

Non-Service Awards: These funds are typically scholarship awards, which can be based on merit, need or other criteria; examples include the NC Lottery Scholarship awards, Chancellor's Carolina Scholars awards, and a large number & variety of specific named scholarship awards to students.

TA / RA / Temp comp: All payments to students on payroll are included under this category, for any and all work on campus. This figure includes federal work study if applicable, temporary student wages, teaching assistant wages, research assistant wages, and applicable fringe benefits. This compensation can come from all over campus, including centers & institutes.

Tuition Support: These funds are typically provided as a remission from tuition that a student would normally otherwise be charged. They can come from a variety of sources, such as the SPH tuition remissions, departmental tuition awards, in-state student tuition status for out of state students, etc. These awards typically reduce a students required tuition payment, but may not be paid directly to a student.
