






That's awful! Why is it so complicated?

- **What kind of endpoints (computers, phones, tablets)?**
- **Need to share audio, video, content (data, screen, application, text chat)?**
- **One-way or multidirectional sharing?**
- **Real time/live access or on-demand?**
- **Access from anywhere?**
- **One-time or recurring?**
- **Involves sensitive data?**
- **Who authorizes access?**
- **Importance of collaboration?**
- **Needs testing in advance to ensure quality?**
- **Time sensitivity/deadlines?**
- **Tech support needs?**
- **Impact/response time if technical issues?**
- **Participants' comfort level with technology?**
- **Budget?**
