- 1. Have a good understanding for what you would like to do next.** This may be more than one area, but do consider:
 - the population you would like to work with
 - the industry you would like to work in
 - the skills you would like to use or build
- 2. Get your job search materials together.** These might include:
 - resume/CV
 - cover letter
 - writing sample
 - elevator pitch
- 3. Begin searching.** There are some basic resources you will want to explore, including:
 - Careerolina and the public health widget
 - Indeed.com (a site that aggregates positions based on your search parameters)
 - Idealist.org (for non-profit opportunities)
 - LinkedIn.com (especially useful for networking)
 - USAJobs.gov (for federal jobs)
 - HigherEdJobs.com (for jobs in academia)
