Pre-Graduate Educational Advising Program**

Share your valuable insights with undergraduate students interested in attending graduate school. As a volunteer you will gain unique advising, mentoring, and promotional experience that will enhance your professional development.

Pre-Grad Advisors generally hold one bi-weekly office hour during the school year where they mentor undergraduates by answering questions concerning the graduate school application process, the GRE, letters of recommendation, and a variety of other topics related to the future of their education. In addition, advisors actively engage in student outreach and promoting the program's resources. Volunteers should expect to spend less than 20 hours per semester total participating in PGEAP office hours and events.

**The application deadline is June 16, 2017.** Please note that to be chosen to interview as a potential Pre-Grad Advisor, you must be able to schedule one on-campus interview between July 10th and July 26th and you must be able to attend the all-day orientation on August 18.
