Interns will each have a specific project on which they will focus during the course of the internship, that will be tied to their set of skills. Additional tasks can be supplemented to allow interns to build the skills they seek. Placements will be in Miami, with field work possibilities in Ecuador, Guatemala, Nicaragua, and Peru. Interns will receive a stipend, and travel expenses in focus countries will be covered.

Position Requirements: Fluency in Spanish (reading, writing, speaking); excellent written and verbal communication skills; strong analytical skills; computer skills, including Google applications; passion for sexual and reproductive health and rights. Must be available for orientation the **week of May 30th**. Internships 10 weeks minimum preferred; exact hours per week and number of weeks can be negotiated. Public health, law, business, communications and international development students are especially encouraged to apply.
