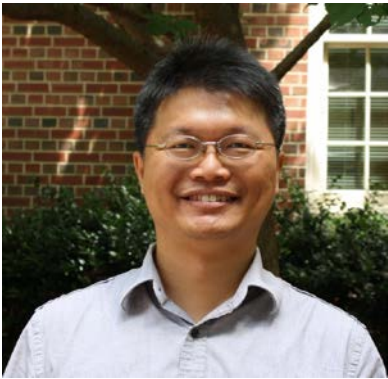

## **Working as a biostatistician: My life in the North Carolina Translational and Clinical Science Institute (NC TraCS)**
