Summary of Professional Experience

Elizabeth McClure, a perinatal epidemiologist in the Center for Clinical Research Network Coordination (CRNC) at RTI International, has more than 15 years of experience in leading global research in maternal and newborn health. Since 2001, in collaboration with the National Institutes of Health (NIH) scientists, she has served as an investigator for the Global Network for Research of Women's and Children's Health. The Global Network has conducted research in India, Pakistan, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Zambia, Kenya, Guatemala, and Argentina to address the major causes of maternal and newborn mortality in low-resource settings. Global Network studies have addressed many interventions, including misoprostol, antenatal corticosteroids, neonatal resuscitation, emergency obstetric, and neonatal care. As the principal investigator of the Global Network data center, Dr. McClure leads data analyses and provides oversight of study implementation. In collaboration with the Global Network, Dr. McClure leads a Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation-funded cluster-randomized trial of ultrasound screening in antenatal care to identify and refer women with pregnancy complications. Dr. McClure also serves as a co-investigator of Maternal and Neonatal Directed Assessment of Technology (MANDATE), a mathematical model to evaluate the impact of interventions to reduce maternal, fetal, and newborn mortality in sub-Saharan African and India. She earned her bachelor's degree in psychology and her doctorate in epidemiology from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She currently serves as a scientific advisor to the International Stillbirth Association. Dr. McClure has had a special interest in stillbirth and has written numerous scientific papers on the topic of stillbirth in low-income countries.
