Step-by-step Guide to Completing Required Training in the Protection of Human Research Subjects

- You do not have to complete all the modules at once. CITI is designed for you to work at your own pace, and allows you to exit and return at a later date to where you left off.
1. Go to www.citiprogram.org
 2. Click on “Log In” and then “Log In Through My Institution.”
 3. Scroll down and click on “University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.” Login using your ONYEN.
 4. Expand the **University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Courses** bar and click on “Add a Course.”
 5. Select “**I would like to review the Human Subjects Protection (“IRB”) modules**” option. Click **Next**.
 6. Select whether you have completed the CITI UNC-Chapel Hill Basic Course and click **Next**.
 7. Within the **Human Subjects Protection (“IRB”) modules**, you are required to take “**Group 1 - Biomedical Research**” **OR** “**Group 2 - Social and Behavioral Research.**” **Group 3 – Data Only -- is not acceptable.**
 8. It is not necessary to complete any optional modules unless you already know that one or more are pertinent to the research you plan to do (i.e., international research; research with children).
 9. Once CITI training is completed, send an email to epidemiology@unc.edu letting us know so that we can generate the certificate of completion.
