## Apply to MRT-TI

<b>MRT-TI Application</b>	Applicants are required to fill out the application found on the program website. Please note that application and enrollment for the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill is a separate process and should not be confused with the application and enrollment for the Mary Rose Tully Training Initiative.
<b>Transcripts</b>	Unofficial transcripts are accepted. Please visit the <a href="#">IBLCE website</a> for a list of qualifying prerequisite classes. Students are responsible for ensuring their classes meet the IBLCE requirements.
<b>Letters of Recommendation</b>	Applicants are required to submit two letters of recommendation. Current or past employers, advisors, co-workers and professors are examples of individuals who may submit a letter on your behalf.
<b>International Students</b>	International students should contact the Program Director to determine if there are any additional requirements or deadlines.

## Accepted students apply to take courses at UNC Chapel Hill by the method below that applies:

The two courses associated with MRT-TI are considered MHCH electives. Enrollment will be handled by the Program Director and the MCH Academic Coordinator.	Some employees may be eligible to apply for a tuition waiver. Please reference this website. If you are unable to utilize a waiver, you may apply through the Friday Center.	Students at a school that participates in an inter-institutional agreement with UNC Chapel Hill may be eligible to apply for the two courses. Contact your institution's registrar and your home institute advisor for more information.	Applicants can enroll through the Friday Center through the <a href="#">Friday Center Post-Baccalaureate for Part-time Studies</a> program.

## Tuition and Fees

The tuition cost depends on method of entry into the program and residency status. For students entering the program not as a current student at UNC, tuition and fees will be classified under "non degree studies graduate". **All students pay an additional Clinical Practicum fee of \$4000.00.** Current tuition rates can be viewed on the [UNC Cashier website](#). Tuition rates are subject to change based on State of NC and University of North Carolina System budget guidance. Prospective students need to be aware that there may be fees associated with the purchasing of the required textbook, scrubs for clinical rotations, parking at clinical sites, required immunizations, fees for Basic Life Support certification and application fees.

## Additional Requirements

<b>Immunizations and Health Form</b>	Once accepted to the program, students will be required to submit proof of immunizations to include: TB, MMR, TDAP, Varicella, Hepatitis B, seasonal Influenza and COVID-19. The exact requirements for submitting information will be shared once accepted to the program. Accepted students will need to have their MRT-TI Immunization and Health forms signed by their healthcare provider.
<b>Basic Life Support</b>	The American Heart Association BLS for Providers course is the only course accepted. Students will need to provide proof of course completion and remain compliant with training for the duration of the program.
<b>Personal Health Insurance</b>	Students will be expected to provide proof of personal health insurance.
<b>Background check</b>	Students will need to successfully pass a background check prior to starting the program. The fee associated with the background check is included within the Clinical Practicum fee and is not refundable.
<b>Drug screen</b>	Students will need to successfully pass a drug screen prior to the start of the program. The fee associated with the drug screen is included within the Clinical Practicum fee and is not refundable.
<b>Lab Coat</b>	Students are required to wear a program lab coat to clinical sites. The fee is included in the Clinical Practicum fee and is not refundable.
