*Nutrition and Dietetics: Students must take NUTR 711, 712, 714 and 715 prior to beginning their practicum hours. As part of an accredited program by ACEND, Nutrition and Dietetics students must complete a minimum of 400 practicum hours (equivalent to ten weeks of full-time work), that take place within a public health/health department and/or hospital/clinical setting and be mentored by an on-site registered dietitian/nutritionist.
