Curriculum

All majoring students need to complete 42 major credits:

- 13 credits (4 classes) of public health core coursework
- 17 credits (5 classes) of health behavior (HBEH) coursework
- 3 credits (1 class) of additional specified public health coursework
- 9 credits (3 classes) of additional approved electives
- Optional 6 credits (2 classes) of independent honors research
