 - Register for EPID 994 (3 credits)
 - Submission of proposal defense forms
- IRB approval and submission of Verification of IRB Compliance form
- Submission of Verification of Submission of Manuscript form
- Interim Meeting of Doctoral Committee
- Final defense of dissertation
 - Obtain requisite forms from Academic Coordinator (DO NOT USE ONLINE FORMS)
 - Register for EPID 994 (3 credits)
 - Submission of final defense forms
- Electronic submission of dissertation to Graduate School after advisor approves submission
